Aberdeen Area



Fishing Report

The ice on all area lakes and rivers is deteriorating quickly with this spring weather. The ice is breaking away from the shoreline making ice fishing dangerous. There are some open areas along the James River where anglers can do some shore fishing.



Hunting Report

Snow Geese: Snow geese have arrived in South Dakota. The current location of the snows are around northern Spink county and into southern Brown County.

Clark County



Fishing Report

Clark County has been fairly quiet for fishing activity lately. A lot of shore access is already worsening and melting. Some anglers walking out but be cognizant of day to day ice change.



Hunting Report

Most snow geese are pushed through the county with the occasional flocks requesting a fly by.

Fishing Report

With warmer temperatures, fishermen are reminded to use caution when accessing and moving around on the ice.

Goose: Fishermen continue to catch a few walleyes in the mornings and evenings. Most walleye continue to be under 14 inches long. Fishermen are still finding a few perch; the perch are in the 11-13 inch range when you find them.



Hunting Report

Snow Geese: A few small flocks of snow geese can be found around the county, if the warm weather this week holds true, we could have a larger push into the area by this weekend.
